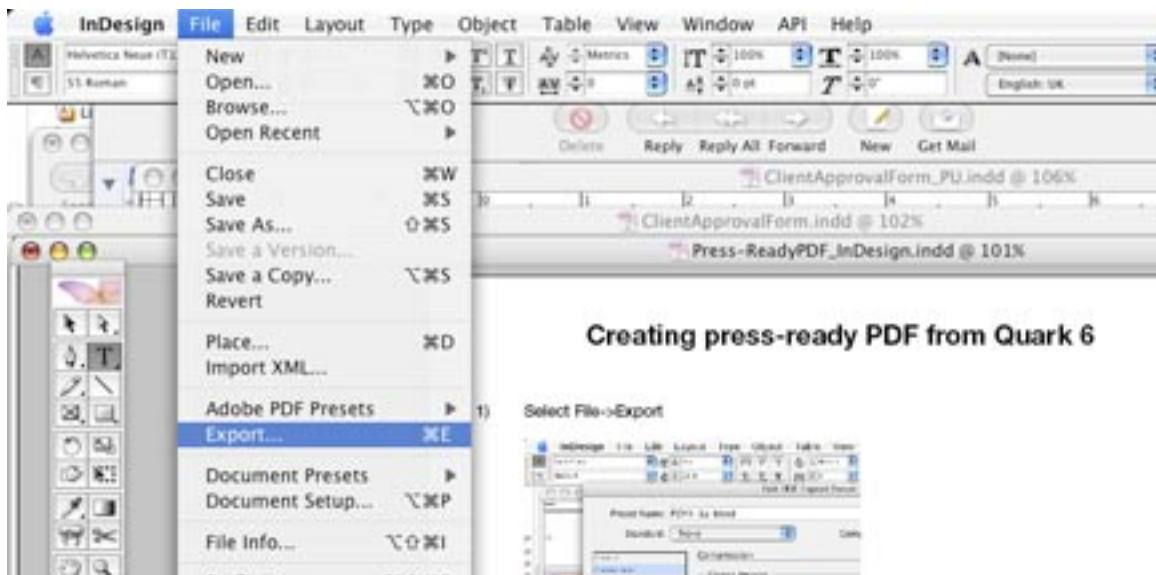
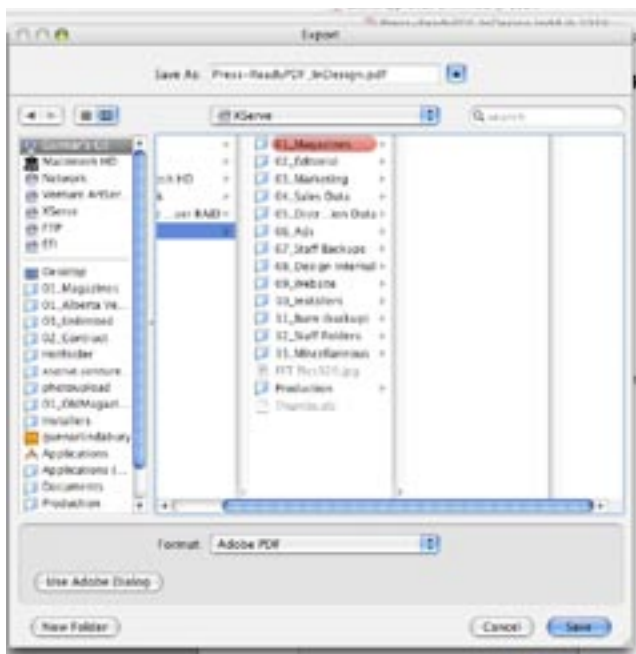


Creating press-ready PDF from InDesign

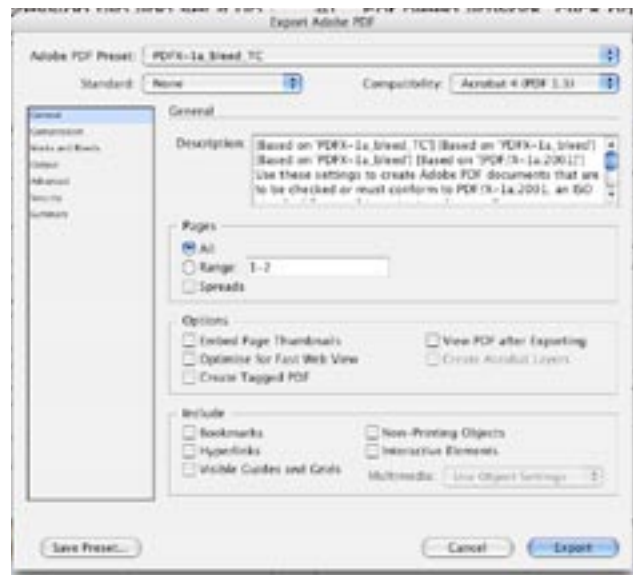
- 1) Select File->Export (or apple-E on your keyboard)



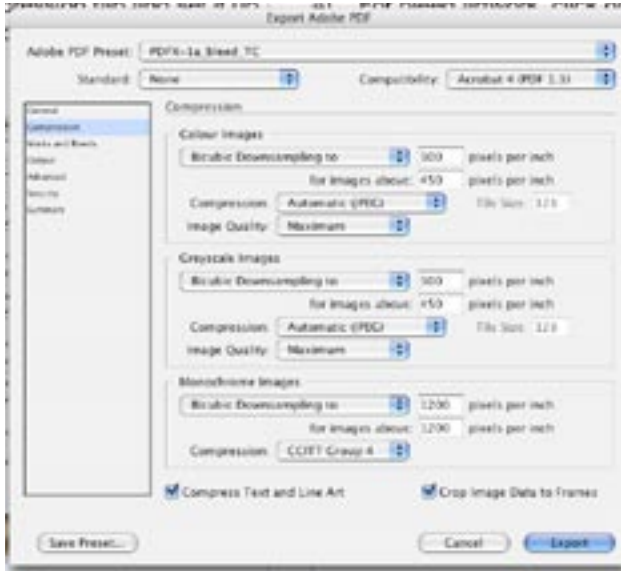
- 2) Find your target folder, make sure the target format is PDF and hit "Save"



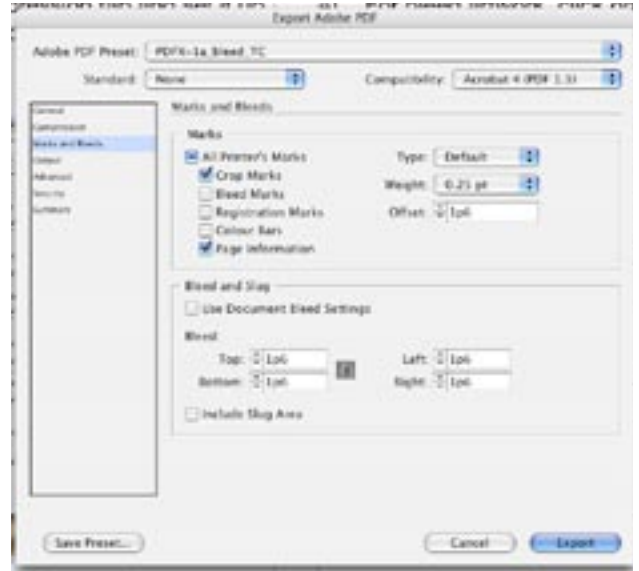
- 3) Make sure the compatibility is Acrobat 4 and you've got the right page range



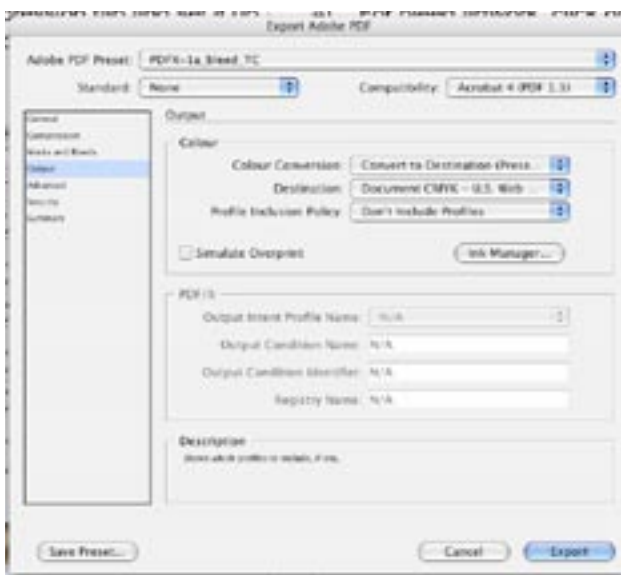
- 4) Click on the Compression tab and set it up as per the image below



- 5) For bleed artwork, click on the Marks and Bleeds tab and set it up as per the image below. For non-bleed, use no printer marks and bleeds of '0'.



- 5) Click on the Output tab and set it so the colour is all CMK as below.



- 6) Click on the Advanced tab. Make sure there is NO OPI, and that your Transparency Flattener is set to High Resolution. You may wish to save this Preset before hitting Export
